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Welcome back to the Spring term at St Marie's. We hope that you had a peaceful and relaxing break.

Homework in Year 4

Years 3 and 4 - 1.5 hours per week (approximately)

Activities: Reading, Spelling, Comprehension, Grammar and Punctuation, Times Tables, Numeracy Skills, RE, Topic Work. Activities Homework will not, in general, be used to finish off work started in class.

The school believes that a regular pattern is important, particularly for English and Mathematics.

Homework Expectations: (Weekly)

- Read regularly (every day if possible!) and record the books which have been read on a reading sheet or reading record book. A sentence about what they have read is even better!
- Learn spelling lists. There will be a spelling test on Tuesdays.
- Complete one test from Schofield and Sims (or spend half an hour on Schofield and Sims maths work every week.)

Homework may also include the following:

- On-going topicwork.
- Writing or punctuation and grammar (SPaG) activities.
- Research/ projects linked to other subject areas.

In this class, homework is given out on **Friday and is to be returned the following **Wednesday**.**

Reading and Comprehension	Please ensure that your child reads for at least 20 minutes at home every day. They can record the books they read on their reading sheet. Please try to listen to your child read at least three times a week (more if possible!) and check their understanding by asking questions about what they are reading. The children will earn reward points/raffle tickets for handing in their reading chart with the books they have read recorded and each square signed by a parent.
Mathematics Homework	The children will be given a Schofield and Sims maths book to work in. They are expected to spend approximately half an hour working in their book and complete no more than one test per week. Please encourage your child to work independently but provide support if needed.
Spellings to learn	Your child will usually be given a list of spellings to learn. Please encourage your child to learn them in a multi-sensory way- see the school website for videos which illustrate this.
Other	The children will also be given other activities to do including research and topic work. Spelling, punctuation and grammar activities will be set using an online site called 'spag.com'.

In Year 4, the children will be given a homework letter which contains all the homework activities for each half term.

This term, we will be learning about

<p>This term the children will be taught the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Local church: Community Eucharist-relating: Giving and Receiving Lent/Easter-Giving: Sacrifice World faith: Islam 	<p>This term we will continue with our 'Science Fiction' topic and then move on to 'World War II' - linked to our local history topic.'</p> <p>Writing: We will be covering: diary writing, story writing, descriptive writing, newspaper report writing, persuasive writing and playscript writing.</p> <p>SPAG: (Spelling, punctuation and grammar) This is taught in school to ensure that children understand how to write correctly and know the terminology used to describe the English language. We will be teaching children about different word types, including: nouns (common nouns, proper nouns, pronouns, abstract nouns and collective nouns) verbs, adverbs, adjectives, determiners, conjunctions and prepositions. We will also be teaching children about tense, including the present perfect and past progressive.</p> <p>For spelling, your child will be taught spelling rules and given weekly spelling lists to learn, based on the spelling lessons in school and also from the National Curriculum Y3/4 word list.</p>	<p>This term the children will be taught the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Subtraction <i>Using expanded decomposition to subtract.</i> Place value, Decimals and negative numbers Written addition and subtraction <i>(Using written methods to add, subtract and solve problems.)</i> Multiplication and division <i>(Recall xtable facts up to 12x12; use written methods to solve problems)</i> Geometry: shapes and co-ordinates <i>(Describe and classify 2D/3D shapes according to their properties. Plot co-ordinates on a grid.)</i> Decimals and Fractions Measurement and data. <i>(Use different units of measure. Calculate perimeter, solve time problems and estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence. Use and create charts and graphs .)</i>

<p>This term we will begin with a topic entitled States of Matter. In this unit, the children will investigate solid, liquids and gases, including their properties. They will also learn about the processes in which changes in state occur and which are irreversible/reversible</p>	<p>This term we will be focussing particularly on online safety, particularly during 'Safer Internet Day 2019' and also how software can be used to perform tasks and achieve goals, including storing/searching for information in databases and presenting information.</p>	<p>PE is taught on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons by SUCF (Sheffield united Community football) and LINKs. Y4 SB will continue to go swimming on Friday mornings this term.</p> <p><i>Children can come to school in their PE kit on Wednesdays and Thursdays.</i></p> <p><i>Please make sure all items of clothing are labelled. No jewellery is allowed to be worn in PE lessons.</i></p>
