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Progress in reading, writing and maths

These scores show how much progress pupils made in reading, writing and maths between the end of key stage 1 and the end of key stage 2, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1. Most schools have progress scores between -5 and +5.

A score above zero means pupils made more progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 1. The National Average is zero.

A negative progress score does not mean pupils made no progress, or the school has failed, rather it means pupils in the school made less progress than other pupils across England with similar results at the end of key stage 1.

Average score in reading, maths and SPAG

This score is known as the 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school in reading, maths and SPAG. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.
