School Uniform Policy

The school uniform colour is **navy blue**

- Navy blue jumper or cardigan with school logo
- White Polo Shirt with school logo
- Navy blue hoodies with school logo must only be worn on PE days.

Please note the jumper/cardigan must not be replaced by the school fleece. The school fleece should be worn outside only.

Boys: Plain navy trousers (not combat style) or navy school shorts. Plain black, navy or grey socks (no logo or cartoon characters).

Girls: Plain navy school trousers (not combat style)/skirt/shorts/culottes/pinafore dress or optional light blue and white check summer dress. Plain black or navy socks (no logo, cartoon characters, or knee high patterned/striped socks.) White socks are permitted during warmer weather if worn with summer dresses.. Plain navy or black tights.

Reception Children: As above for boys and girls. In addition, all-in-one waterproof outdoor clothing or waterproof trousers and waterproof coat, Wellington boots and a bookbag.

Footwear: Black sensible shoes. Black boots or ankle boots are acceptable in winter. For Health and Safety reasons we are unable to allow open toe sandals. **No trainers**, except on PE days, **and no fashion shoes. No visible logos.**

PE Kit: House team colour active wear t-shirt, navy blue shorts for indoor PE and navy blue track suit bottoms and navy blue hoodie with school logo for outdoor PE and cooler weather. If leggings are worn for PE they must be navy blue. Plain trainers or plimsolls for. Children should tie their hair up during PE lessons.

Jewellery: Children may wear only a pair of stud earrings and a watch: No hooped earrings, necklaces, rings or bracelets are allowed. However, children may wear a small crucifix, for religious purposes, but this must be worn underneath their shirt and not worn for PE.

For Health and Safety reasons children may not participate in PE if wearing earrings. Please ensure that they can remove them themselves or do not wear them on day of PE or Swimming.

Hair: The school does not allow extremes of hair fashion i.e. no lines, cuts, patterns, shaved heads, or obvious dyeing of the hair or coloured hair extensions. Please check with school first if you are unsure. Hair should look natural. Elaborate hair accessories are not allowed

- Hair must be kept tidy in the interests of safety and long hair should be tied back.
- No marks/cuts allowed in eyebrows.

Clothing should be clearly labelled with the child's name, including coats.

Hoodies, sweatshirts and denim jackets are not considered to be coats.

If a child's clothing is not labelled, staff will write the child's name in the item of clothing.

In all matters concerning uniform, the Headteacher's decision is final.

If in doubt about an item, please contact the Headteacher or the school office before purchase.
